Medicare recipients: To serve the aging members of our community that live on a fixed income, this 10% discount can help you get the medicines and relief you need while relieving some of the financial worry. Simply show your card — no other documents or application processes necessary.

MO HealthNet/Medicaid recipients: It's hard to get ahead on a low income, so we offer this discount to help spread those dollars a little further. We want you to be able to get your needed medicine and still have the money for other necessities. Simply show your card — no other documents or application processes required for eligibility.


